YourSmileDental offers simple, direct debit payment plans for Larger Procedures / Treatment through **DentiCare**. **DentiCare** is a third-party Direct Debit Payment Plan, so we can focus on you, your smile, and your dental healthcare needs. This means that you can receive the treatment you need now, without having to worry about full payment upfront. The payment plans can be customised to suit your individual needs.

- Simple, one-page Direct Debit payment plan form
- No interest on your treatment
- Only a one time set up fee of \$49
- Choose from Credit Card or Bank Account debits
- **Payment Terms:** \$6,000 - \$9,000 (12 months) | \$9,001 - \$12,000 (18 months)
- Choose your repayment period and direct debit frequency (Maximum 18 months)
- Simply pay a deposit (30% minimum) directly to **YourSmileDental** and the balance is put on a **DentiCare** Payment Plan.
- Deposit can be a combination of direct HICAPS (private health fund) payment and direct payments
- Start your treatment straight away and spread the cost over time

There is no credit or finance contracts for our practice payment plans. So please feel at ease and talk to us about payment plans so you can fulfil your dental and oral care needs.

Direct Debit Example

Imagine a situation where a patient needs \$7000 of treatment.

You pay \$2100 up front (30% of the total cost) and then also set up a payment plan. This enables you to pay the remaining \$4900 over an agreed time.

An example plan could involve you paying \$273 a month over a period of 18 months via direct debit.

Who is eligible for Direct Debit Payment Plan?

To be eligible for a **DentiCare** Payment plan you must be over 18, employed, not currently bankrupt and an Australian citizen. There are no complicated credit checks or approvals with a **DentiCare** payment plan, so you can get setup and start treatment the same day!
